



BASIC FACTS ON OHIO'S CHARTER SCHOOLS AND CHARTER SCHOOL AUTHORIZERS

Note: authorizers in Ohio are also referred to as “sponsors.”

At the end of the 2012-13 school year Ohio had 370 schools serving about 130,000 students across the state.

In 2012-13 there were 66 approved charter school authorizers in Ohio.

The following entities can authorize charter schools in Ohio:

- The board of education of the school district in which the school is located;
- The board of education of any joint vocational school district with territory in the county in which is located the majority of the territory of the district in which the school is proposed to be located;
- The board of education of any other city, local or exempted village school district operating in the same county in which is located the majority of the territory of the district in which the school is proposed to be located;
- The governing board of any educational service center (with some limitations);
- A sponsoring authority designated by the board of trustees of any of the 13 state universities;
- Any qualified tax-exempt entity under section 501(c)3 of the IRS code as long as the following conditions are satisfied:
 - The entity has been in operation for at least five years prior to applying to be a community school sponsor.
 - The entity has assets of at least \$500,000 and a demonstrated record of financial responsibility.
 - The Ohio department of education has determined that the entity is an education-oriented entity.
- In 2013-14, the Mayor of Columbus can serve as a charter school authorizer.
