Second Amendment to

The Community School Contract entered into by The Governing Authority of Dayton Leadership Academics – Dayton View Campus and The Thomas B. Fordham Foundation

This Amendment is entered into effective as of the 16th day of June, 2014 by and between The Governing Authority ("Governing Authority") of Dayton Leadership Academies – Dayton View Campus (the "Community School") and the Thomas B. Fordham Foundation ("Fordham"), sponsor of the Community School.

WHEREAS, the Governing Authority and Fordham previously entered into a Community School Contract dated April 26, 2013, as modified from time to time ("Sponsorship Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the Governing Authority and Fordham desire to amend the Sponsorship Contract as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The last sentence of the second paragraph of Article I is hereby modified and amended to read:

The Community School is educating children in grade or equivalent grade levels 3-8 beginning for the 2014-2015 school year.

- 2. The Community School and Sponsor confirm the remainder of the term contract of one year expiring June 30, 2015.
- 3. Exhibit 1, Education Plan is hereby modified and amended to incorporate and include Exhibit 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 4. The Community School will fully cooperate with Sponsor's requirement for site visits in 2015 by an external evaluation team selected by Sponsor as well as cooperate and implement recommendations from the evaluation as updates to and modifications of Exhibit 1, subject to approval by the Sponsor. Implementation of the recommendations must be deemed satisfactory by the Sponsor as a precondition for renewal of the Contract.
- 5. The Governing Authority and Fordham represent and affirm that the Sponsorship Contract is in full force and effect and both parties have met all obligations with respect thereto. The parties further represent and affirm that all necessary and proper actions have been taken to authorize and approve this Amendment.
- 6. The terms and conditions of the Sponsorship Contract not modified herein are reaffirmed as if fully set forth herein. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between this Amendment and the Sponsorship Contract, the terms and conditions contained in this Amendment shall control and prevail in all respects. This Amendment may be executed in any

number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall be deemed to constitute one and the same document.
